Dear Parents/Carers,

In line with guidance to constantly review and update our risk assessments these are some of the changes that will come into effect from Monday 20th September.

Myself & Chris will be wearing a face covering when we welcome you onto the school site at the start and end of the school day.

Children will be given a school packed lunch instead of a hot meal so that they can eat in their year group learning spaces. You are very welcome to send in a packed lunch from home if you would prefer.

Children in Parrots & Penguins will have lunchtimes in the FS2 indoor and outdoor learning spaces. They will have time on the main playground when other classes are not out there playing.

Children in Toucans will eat their lunch in the hall. They will have their lunchtime playtime on the main playground.

Children in Year 2 will eat their lunch in their classrooms. They will have their lunchtime playtime on the artificial grass at the side of school and in the Garden Area.

Mid-day supervisors will be assigned to a single year group for lunchtime and they will supervise the same group of children for the remainder of this term.

I am very pleased with how the start of the school day / nursery sessions are going. At the end of the day to minimise large groups waiting in a relatively small area the gate will open at 2.45pm and you will be able to collect your child from school from this time. Hopefully this will give a longer stagger time and enable us to get children out more quickly to you.

I want to reassure you that we are doing everything we can to keep your child, staff and yourselves safe. Supervised and regular handwashing remains in place, as does the sanitising of resources and an enhanced cleaning regime.
